An apprenticeship program requires a combination of on-the-job and classroom training. To meet the Pennsylvania State requirements for journeyman status, an apprentice must be registered with the state and attend 144 classroom hours concurrently with 2000 hours of practical on-the-job experience per year with their employer. With the NTMA Apprenticeship classes, apprentices can complete the classroom training requirement through convenient, one evening per week classes. If a trainee is not enrolled in a formal apprenticeship at the worksite, they may still attend classes. Contact us for options about our group sponsored program.
